ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 52 OF
ORDINANCE 90-1 RELATING TO THE AMOUNT
OF THE DISTRICT'S PARTICIPATION CHARGE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SOUTH PLACER MUNICIPAL
UTILITY DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1

Section 52: A basic participation charge for each equivalent
dwelling unit shall be the sum of \$3,950.00.

Section 2

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the
1st day of July 1992.

Section 3

This ordinance was introduced at a regular meeting of the Board of
Directors on the 7th day of May, 1992.

Section 4


Upon final passage, this ordinance shall be published once a week for

District pursuant to the provisions of Sections 11534 and 11910 of the
Public Utilities Code.





Subject: Report and Recommendation Regarding The
Increase In S/PMUD's Participation Charge

Board Members:

Pursuant to the provisions of a) Section 14401 of the Public Utilities Code, b) Section 3d, 1 of the agreement dated June 17, 1981 between this District and the City of Roseville, and c) the report and recommendation dated February 5, 1992 from the District's Financial Consultant, Bartle Wells Associates, it is my recommendation that the portion of the District's participation charge representing the regional connection fee be raised to \$2,750.00 per equivalent dwelling unit.

A copy of the Bartle Wells Associates financial report dated February 5, 1992 is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 14401 of the Public Utilities Code requires the Board to hold a public hearing within 40 days of the filing of this report and recommendation, and that notice of the time and place of the hearing shall be published once a week for two successive weeks. The Attorney for the District will prepare the required Notice of Hearing for this purpose.
