ORDINANCE NO. 3

DETERMINING THAT THE ANNEXATION OF LEE MINE BASIN, GRANITE BAY and OLIVE RANCH WOAD, UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY, WILL FAGILITATE THE OPERATION OF A PUBLIC UTILITY BY THE MOCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT AND BE OF ADVANTAGE TO SAID DISTRICT, DETERMINING AND SETTING FORTH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UPON WHICH SAID TERRITORY MAY BE ANNEXED TO SAID DISTRICT AND DECLARING THE INTENTION OF CAUSING THE SAME TO DE APPROVED BY SAID DISTRICT, AND GIVING MOTICE OF THE TIME AND PLACE FIXED FOR HEARING THEREON

MADEREAD, a potition, addressed to the Beard of Directors of the ROCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT, describing LEE MINE RASIN,
GRANITE BAY and OLIVE RASCH ROAD UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY and requesting that proceedings be taken for their annexation to said District, has been filed with the Secretary of said District, and said Secretary has ascertained and determined that said petition has been signed by all of the owners of the real property described therein and duly verified by the Affidavit of one of the petitioners, and said Secretary has attached his signature to said petition and presented the same to said Board of Directors; and

the advisability of annexing said territory and the terms and conditions upon which such annexation should be made; NOW, THEREFORE.

SE IT SNACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE ROCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT:

Section 1: That the annexation of LEE MINE BASIN, GRANITE BAY and OLIVE RANCH ROAD UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY will facilitate the operation of a public utility by said District and be of advantage to said District and that such territory should be annexed to said District upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth in Section 2.

Section 2: That the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth for the annexation of LEE MINE BASIN, GRANITE BAY and OLIVE RANCH ROAD UNINCORP.

ORATED TERRITORY are found and determined by said Board of Directors to be satisfactory and agreeable and said Board of Directors does hereby declare its intention of causing the same to be approved by said District.

Said terms and conditions are as follows:

- (a) Sewage service and other facilities provided by the MOCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT shall be supplied under the rules and regulations of said District and charged for at such rates as the Board of Directors of said District may from time to time prescribe for like service and facilities elsewhere in said District.
- (b) Said territory shall be subject to all taxes, tolls and charges which are or may be from time to time levied by the Board of Directors of said District upon the property within the said ROCKLIN-LOCKIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT for all District purposes, including taxes to pay the principal and interest on any outstanding bonded indebtedness of said District;
- (c) The owners of the real property within said territory shall pay to said District on demand a sum equal to the amount of Twenty-five cents (.25) per \$100.00 assessed valuation of the 1957-1958 tax rolls, Fifty Cents (.50) per \$100.00 assessed valuation of the 1958-1959 tax rolls, and Fifty Cents (.50) per \$100.00 assessed valuation of the 1959-1960 tax rolls.

Section 3: UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY described as follows:

Bection 4: This Ordinance, which contains the notice fixing the time and place for hearing thereon, shall be published once in the LOOMIS NEWS, a newspaper of general circulation published in said District, and such publication shall constitute due notice of said hearing and no other notice need be given.

Section 5: Notice of the hearing referred to in Section 4 is hereby given as follows:

NOTICE FIXING TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING ON THE QUESTION OF THE APPROVAL BY THE ROCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE ANNEXATION OF LEE MINE BASIN, GRANITE BAY AND OLIVE RANCH ROAD UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the ROCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT has fixed Friday, the 5th day of February, 1960, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m. of said day and the office of the ROCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT, HIGHWAY #40, Loomis, California, as the time and place for hearing on the question of the approval by the ROCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT of the terms and conditions set forth in Section 2 or Ordinance No. 3 of said Board of Directors for the annexation of LEE MINE BASIN, GRANITE BAY and OLIVE RANCH ROAD UNINCORPORATED TRARITORY, in the County of Placer, State of California, more particularly described in Section 3 of said Ordinance.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that at the time and place fixed horsin, or at such time and place to which such hearing may be adjoured, any person interested may file written objections to the approval of such terms and conditions with the Board of Directors of said District. Failure of any person interested in said District or in the matter of the proposed annexation on said terms and conditions, to show cause in writing as aforesaid shall constitute an assent on his part to a change in the boundaries of said District shall determine whether or not said terms and conditions shall be approved and shall hear and determine all objections thereto.

Section 6: A copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Secretary of said District.

Section 7: This Ordinance shall take offect immediately.
