ORDINANCE NO. 01-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1
AND RE-ENACTING SECTION 2 OF
ORDINANCE NO. 98-01 RELATING TO
PARTICIPATION CHARGES AND
MONTHLY SERVICE CHARGES

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SOUTH PLACER MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 98-01 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1:

A basic participation charge for each equivalent dwelling unit is hereby fixed and established as follows:

<u>Calendar Years</u>	<u>Local Charge</u>	<u>Regional Charge</u>
January 2002 through December 2003	\$1,500.00	\$3,390.00 ¹

¹ Plus increases as recommended to the District by the South Placer Wastewater Authority.

Section 2

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 98-01 is hereby re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 2

A monthly service charge for each equivalent dwelling unit is hereby fixed and established as follows:

<u>Fiscal Year</u>	<u>Monthly Charge</u>
2001/02	\$16.00
2002/03	\$16.00

Section 3

Such monthly service charge and/or local share of the participation charge may be changed from time to time by ordinance.

Section 4

This Ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2002.

Section 5

This Ordinance was introduced at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors held on the 4th day of October 2001.

Section 6

Upon final passage, this Ordinance shall be published once a week for two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the District, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 11534 and 11910 of the Public Utilities Code.
