**ORDINANCE NO 63-3**

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN PROPOSED ROCKLIN-LOOMIS MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT, SPECIAL DISTRICT NO. 1, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER SAID PROPOSED SPECIAL DISTRICT NO. 1 WILL BE CREATED FOR THE PURPOSES HEREIN SET FORTH AND FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING THE MEASURES OF INCURRING A BONDED INDEBTEDNESS OF SAID SPECIAL DISTRICT NO.1 FOR THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLETION OF THE FOLLOWING IMPROVEMENTS, AND EACH OF THEM, TO WIT: (B) PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES; (C) PUBLIC RECREATIONAL FACILITIES; (D) PUBLIC COMMUNICATION SERVICES; (E) STREET LIGHTS; (F) SEWAGE COLLECTION, TREATMENT AND DISPOSITION FACILITIES; AND (G) GARBAGE AND REFUSE COLLECTION, TREATMENT AND DISPOSITION FACILITIES; DECLARING THE ESTIMATED COST OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS, AND EACH OF THEM, THE AMOUNT OF THE PRINCIPAL OF SAID INDEBTEDNESS TO BE INCURRED THEREFOR, AND THE MAXIMUM RATE OF INTEREST TO BE PAID THEREON; MAKING PROVISION FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES IN SAID SPECIAL DISTRICT NO. 1; AND FIXING THE DATE OF SAID ELECTION, THE MANNER OF HOLDING THE SAME, ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES FOR SAID ELECTION, APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICERS THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Rocklin- Loomis Municipal Utility District (hereinafter called the "Board") (a) by resolution duly passed and adopted at a meeting of the Board duly and regularly held approved the creation of Rocklin-Loomis Municipal Utility District, Special District No. 1 with boundaries as hereinafter referred to; and (b) by resolution duly passed and adopted at a meeting of the Board duly and regularly held, by affirmative vote of more than two-thirds of all its members, did determine that the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition, construction and completion by said Special Dist-

out, or partly within or partly without, said Special District No. 1, works, or parts of works, for supplying the inhabitants of said Special District No. 1, or some of them, with public transportation facilities, public recreational facilities, public communications services, street lights, sewage collection, treatment and disposition facilities, and garbage and refuse collection, treatment and disposition facilities, and to carry out the purposes of said Special District No. 1?

**MEASURE (B):  
(Public Transportation

Shall Rocklin-Loomis Municipal Utility District, Special District No. 1, incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) for the acquisition, construction, and completion of the following improvement, to wit: Public transportation facilities, including buses and service vehicles; garages, maintenance facilities, bus parking areas, and fencing; office and furniture therefor; lands; equipment and machinery; and other works, property or structures necessary or convenient for public transportation facilities and to carry out said purpose of said Special District No. 1?

**MEASURE (C):  
(Public Recreational  
Facilities)**

Shall Rocklin-Loomis Municipal Utility District, Special District No. 1, incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) for the acquisition, construction or completion of the following improvement, to wit: Public recreational facilities, including swimming pools, playing fields and courts, golf courses, play-grounds, parks and parkways, auditoriums and other meeting places, arts and crafts rooms, gymnasiums, recreational reservoirs, beaches, museums, zoos, equestrian trails, stables, corrals and barns, skating rinks, shooting ranges, lighting, fencing, landscaping, sprinkler systems, off street parking facilities, maintenance yards and shops, administrative offices, lands, easements and rights-of-way, machinery, equipment and other works, property or structures necessary or con-

debtedness in the principal amount of Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$7,500,000.00) for the acquisition, construction and completion of the following improvement, to wit: Sewage collection, treatment and disposition facilities, including trunk collection system and pipes, connections, manholes, lift stations and other related facilities therefor; sewage treatment and disposal plants; lands, easements and rights-of-way; and other works, property or structures necessary or convenient for sewage collection, treatment and disposition facilities and to carry out said purpose of said Special District No. 1?

**MEASURE (G):  
(Garbage and Refuse  
Collection, Treatment and  
Disposition Facilities)**

Shall Rocklin-Loomis Municipal Utility District, Special District No. 1, incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for the acquisition, construction and completion of the following improvement, to wit: Garbage and refuse collection, treatment and disposition facilities, including trucks and compactor bodies therefor, refuse containers, incinerator, salvage equipment and other equipment; corporation yard, maintenance shop, office building, fencing, site improvements and equipment maintenance facilities; lands, rights in lands, rights-of-way and easements; and other works, property or structures necessary or convenient for garbage and refuse collection, treatment and disposition facilities and to carry out said purpose of said Special District No. 1?

The estimated cost of the improvement as set forth in Measure (B) (Public Transportation Facilities) is the sum of \$500,000 and the amount of the indebtedness proposed to be incurred for said improvement is the sum of \$500,000.

The estimated cost of the improvement as set forth in Measure (C) (Public Recreational Facilities) is the sum of \$10,000,000 and the amount of the indebtedness proposed to be incurred for said improvements is the sum of \$10,000,000.

(b) All persons qualified to vote at elections in the Special District upon the date of the election herein provided for shall be qualified to vote upon the measures submitted at said special election.

(c) The polls at the polling places hereinafter designated shall be opened at 7:00 o'clock A. M. of said day of election and shall be kept open continuously thereafter until 7:00 o'clock P. M. of said day of election, when the polls shall be closed (except as provided in Section 14436 of the Election Code), and the election officer shall thereupon proceed to canvass the ballots cast thereat.

(d) For the conduct of said special bond election, the Special District is hereby divided into three special election precincts, one of which shall comprise that portion of the City of Rocklin that is within the boundaries of the Special District, one of which shall comprise that portion of Loomis Sanitary District that is within the boundaries of the Special District, and one of which shall comprise the remainder of the Special District (being that portion of the Special District that is unincorporated and outside of the City of Rocklin and outside of Loomis Sanitary District), and each of which shall comprise portions of one or more of the general state and county election precincts within the Special District, as follows: The special election precincts hereinafter designated by letters or numbers each comprises portions of one or more of the general election precincts within the Special District for general state and county election purposes and the general election precincts hereinafter referred to by name or by name and number comprise the general election precincts as named or numbered (and so designated by name or number) for general state and county election purposes by the Board of Supervisors of Placer County, State of California. Reference is hereby made to the records of the Board of Supervisors of said County establishing general election precincts as the same are now on file in the office of the County Clerk of said County for a more particular description of said general election precincts as so named or named and numbered. Reference is hereby also made to said records for descriptions of the boundaries of the City of Rocklin and of Loomis Sanitary Dist-
